- Placing 12 round fruits on the dining table for good luck



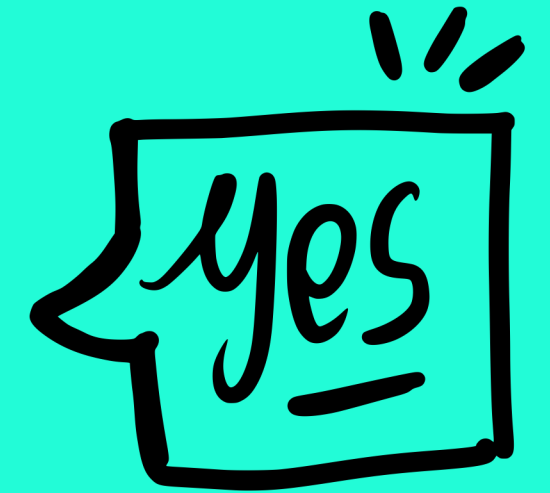
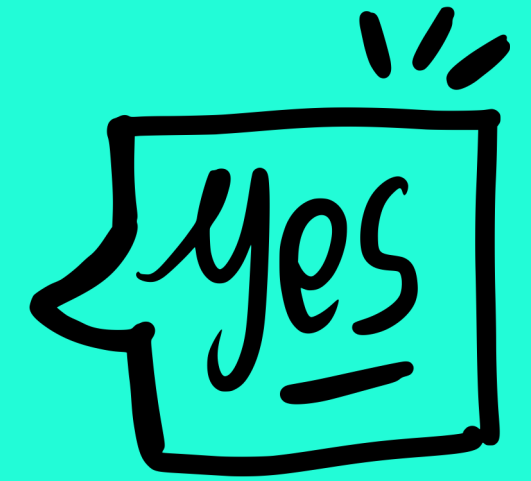
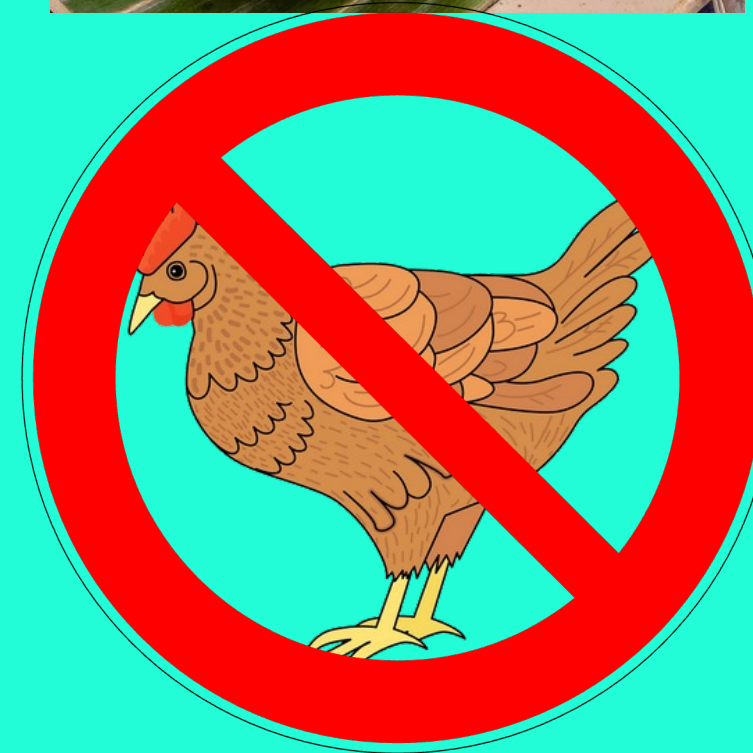
